Acquiring a GESEA Level 2 Certification is an ISFM requirement for obtaining a diploma in obstetrics and gynecology. The SFITS is now an ESGE-accredited training center. It offers high quality training before the certification exam.

LASTT

- Laparoscopic Skills Training and Testing, is designed to measure 3 practical laparoscopic psychomotor skills: the ability of the person to navigate the camera, to handle the 30° optic and to identify required targets.

SUTT

- Suturing and Knot Tying Training and Testing, consists of a series of tests on stitching and knotting to train and test the quality level of needle handling, stitching, tissue approximation and knotting.

HYSTT

- Hysteroscopic Skills Training and Testing, is designed for training and testing of the hysteroscopic psychomotor skills: the ability of a person to navigate the camera, to handle the 30° optic and the ability to handle hysteroscopic tools.
